Coffins and Caskets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Biodegradable • Untreated materials • Derived from sustainable sources • Rope handles • Natural fiber liners and clothing • Metal name plate as per legislative requirements 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lacquers • Varnish • Plastic or metal handles • Embalming with toxic chemicals
Gravesite Area	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One interment per grave • Grave depth 750mm from top of coffin/caskets • Soil will be allowed to settle naturally after interment • Burial position can be selected by customer • Cremation must be in a biodegradable container 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any operation that is not aligned with SMCT safety or regulatory standards
Tributes and Memorials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Floral tributes (such as wreaths, and flower arrangements) are allowed directly after service, however will be removed within a week after service • Only natural flowers • Commemoration at shared memorial rock 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plastic flowers • Grave momentous/trinkets (e.g. candles, soft toys) • Planting on top of graves • SMCT floral and memento policies
Memorialisation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shared rock inscription (in perpetuity) • Individual memorial rock (Not perpetually maintained) sourced from natural rock with inscription, the rock must be no larger than 250 X 250mm 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Granite headstones • Bronze plaques
Plantings and maintenance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Native planting only • Minimal maintenance • Tree maintenance to ensure safety standards 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individual plantings on graves
